
## Norwood Scale



This scale is subject to the patient's density count. Any patient who has less than 70-80 hairs per centimeter squared (can see their scalp thru the hair) will not be able to support large cases, vs. someone with 200-300 hairs per cm2 who will be able to support multiple cases.
