Upon signing to Columbia Records in 1955, the restless genius embarked on a musical path that would find him spearheading every major musical movement of the second half of the 20th Century. No other musical artist would be as all-embracing, influential, and ever-changing, earning him the moniker, "The Picasso of Jazz."

Whether attired in a Brooks Brothers suit elegantly embracing a heartbreaking ballad, or sporting bell bottoms and an Afro and playing pure fire, Miles Davis was the arbiter of all new sounds, new fashions, and the world of ineffable cool. All of this and so much more is captured in this ground-breaking collection.

The Genius of Miles Davis is an unprecedented look into the life of an artist in constant flux, ever- breaking new stylistic ground, changing the social landscape, and in tireless pursuit of that mysterious and intangible quality we call "genius.

THE PACKAGING

THE GENIUS OF MILES DAVIS is the most luxuriously packaged musical collection ever presented. The outer box is an exact replica of the trumpet case he used during his career. A special Miles Davis metal insignia adorns the outside cover. The interior is customized in lush blue velvet, and an iconic, noirish image of Miles adorns the inner wall. As the case is opened, there's Miles Davis in all his dark and mysterious beauty staring at you.

Miles Davis was also an accomplished painter whose work has been consistently shown internationally, and has been the subject of numerous books. Now, a previously unpublished fine art lithograph of one of his most striking paintings has been added to this deluxe collection. Miles's dream-like vision of dancing women provides yet another facet of his extraordinary talent.

Also unique to this collection is an exact replica of the "Gustat" Heim 2 mouthpiece used by Miles during his career. Created exclusively for this collection by Kanstul, the custom-designed mouthpiece, with all of its original detailing, was the medium through which all of Miles's most haunting and beautiful sounds passed through.

The last bonus item to be included in The Genius Of Miles
Davis is a custom-designed T-shirt manufactured exclusively
for this collection by Trunk Ltd. Pictured against a rich black
background is Miles sporting his trademark shades and playing
his one-of-a-kind Martin trumpet.




THE MUSIC

Miles Davis (1926-1991) was the only jazz artist of the 20th Century to spearhead so many clearly- defined musical movments. During a 30 year tenure for Columbia Records, he released over 50 extraordinary albums which were at the very vanguard of the music world. This incredibly fertile period on Columbia Records (1955-1985) would constitute the core of his life's work and come to embody *THE GENIUS OF MILES DAVIS*.

Between 1996-2007, Sony Music Entertainment released 8 deluxe Miles Davis box sets documenting in detail each of these very distinct musical movements. Each box came fitted with a custom-etched metal spine and a substantial book full of sweeping essays, testimonials from musicians, insightful analysis, discographical data, powerful, rarely-seen imagery, and endless amounts of previously unreleased music--all of which was meticulously remastered by Sony's leading engineers. This unparalleled series of box sets has been called the most ambitious reissue campaign in the history of the music industry, and received no less than 8 Grammy Awards.

MILES DAVIS & JOHN COLTRANE: The complete columbia recordings 1955-1961 (6 CDs)

Miles Davis had just signed to Columbia Records and his star was fast on the rise. Assembling groups which would feature John Coltrane, Bill Evans, Cannonball Adderley, and Jimmy Cobb among others, it was during this period that he would create "the greatest jazz album of all time" - the epochal KIND OF BLUE. 116 page book. 
MILES DAVIS & GIL EVANS: THE COMPLETE COLUMBIA STUDIO RECORDINGS (6 CDs)

Gil Evans, the great arranger, had fallen in love with Miles Davis's haunting and melancholy, yet terribly seductive sound. He would craft a series of impeccable arrangements which were tailored to this unique sound. These recordings would take their place among the most important collaborations in all of music. Among them, the timeless masterpieces SKETCHES OF SPAIN, PORGY & BESS, and MILES AHEAD.

SEVEN STEPS: The complete columbia recordings of Miles Davis 1963-1964 (7 CDs)

With the departure of Bill Evans, John Coltrane, and Cannonball Adderley, Miles Davis went in search of a new band. Seven Steps is unique to this collection, as it captures a period of pure transition for the master. In the studio, live from around the world (Berlin, Tokyo, New York, and Juan-les-Pins) and in peak form, this collection covers such great albums as MY FUNNY VALENTINE, FOUR & MORE, and SEVEN STEPS TO HEAVEN. 92 page book. THE MILES DAVIS QUINTET 1965-1968: The complete columbia studio recordings (6 CDs)

Miles and the Young Lions! The Second Great Quintet. In 1965, Miles Davis, for the first time in his life, assembled a band in which he was surrounded by younger musicians who he would propel into stardom, and who would push Miles into new musical frontiers. Wayne Shorter, Herbie Hancock, Ron Carter, and Tony Williams would fast become stars, and write the future of jazz from this point forward. Considered one of the greatest bands to ever exist, they would create the modern masterpieces, E.S.P., MILES SMILES, NEFERTITI, and SORCERER, among others. 116 page book. Grammy Award Winner

THE COMPLETE IN A SILENT WAY SESSIONS (3 CDs)

In 1969, Miles Davis recorded yet another masterpiece. With a completely new sound, concept, and band, *IN A SILENT WAY* was an ethereal, mysterious, and shimmeringly beautiful album, and would point Miles in a new direction—a direction he would follow until the end of his life—The Electric Miles! This box set shines light on the musical process and methodology involved in the making of this masterpiece. 96 page book.

THE COMPLETE BITCHES BREW SESSIONS (4 CDs)

There was nothing ever created like *BITCHES BREW* before it or after it. *BITCHES BREW* featured new, young stars and the provocative, fiery, and passionate playing of Miles Davis. Another masterpiece far beyond category, it established Miles Davis as an artist who could assimilate the sounds of jazz, James Brown, Jimi Hendrix, and Sly Stone in creating something wholly new. And, it appealed to the masses of young rockers who were hearing something vaguely familiar, yet completely unique and powerful.
