Wildwynn Horse Camps are a wonderful and fun way to teach children the responsibility of owning and caring for a horse. Campers will learn barn rules, anatomy, horse and rider safety, horse trivia, tacking up, washing and show grooming, equine nutrition, and much more! Campers will also have daily riding instruction and activities including horse movies. Emphasis is placed on the correct way to ride and handle horses for maximum safety. Each student will work at his or her own level with an emphasis on safety at all times. We provide the horses.

Campers will need to bring a picnic lunch, with plenty of water or other beverage. A refrigerator and microwave are available. Campers will need to wear long pants and shoes or boots with a heel when riding. No flip-flops or sandals are allowed. After the horses are tied and drying, we will have our traditional "water fight", during which the instructors and counselors get the wettest!

The camp fee is \$250.00 per student for full days and \$175.00 per student for half days. Horse camp is rain or shine. Pick up is early only in the case of thunderstorms.
