Precautions and contraindication for microdermabrasion & chemcial peel treatments

- No botox within the last 24 hours
- No waxing with in the last week
- No Retin-A or Differen within the last week
- No Accutance within the last year
- -No Alpha hydroxy acids 5 to 7 days
- -No Laser resurfacing or surgical procedures within the last six months
- -No sunburn, windburn, or broken skin
- -No pregnancy for chemical peel clients
- -No sensitivities or allergies to vitamin A or Salicitic acid

Herpes virus (cold sores) (suggest antiviral 2-3 day before and after)

Auto immune disorders

chemotherapy treatments

history of keloid scarring

plan to have excessive sun exposure post peel

Additional contraindications to microdermabrasion:

- Active, uncontrolled or brittle diabetes
- Viral lesions
- Herpes Simplex
- Shingles
- Eczema or Seborrheic dermatitis
- Rosacea
- Oral blood thinners
- Vitiliago
- Skin cancer and auto immune disorders such as AIDS or HIV
- Visible, broken blood vessels
- Telangectasis
