## **Summer Camps June 2011:**

There will be different lesson plans divided up by a short break every 25 minutes, with one extended break in the middle of the day. Beginning and intermediate levels accepted. **Class Descriptions:**

### **Guitar:**

Learn the basics of playing guitar: tab reading, popular songs, hand positions, rhythm, and more! Students must bring their own guitar (acoustic, classical, or electric).

### **Music Theory:**

Learn the basics of music theory: scales, chord building, keys, and more. Students do not need any instruments to attend music theory classes.

### **Keyboard:**

Learn the basics of keyboard: 5 finger patterns, note reading & theory, simple melodies and more. Students do not need any instruments to attend keyboard classes.

### **Guitar/Bass Ensemble:**

Learn to play in a group ensemble. Popular songs will be chosen by the instructor. Must have your own guitar (any type) or bass, and be able to read music and play chords in first position; and read tablature in first position.

### **Beginning Voice – Group Classes:**

Ever wanted to sing? Your vocal chords are an instrument that needs attention and development, and with practice, *anyone* can sing, sing, sing!! Learn basic singing fundamentals like pitch accuracy, proper breathing, warming up, and much more. Students do not need any instruments to attend vocal classes.

### **Beginning Choir – Group Classes:**

Sing simple popular songs with your peers! Find out what your range is, learn basics of music reading, fundamentals of singing technique, and how to sing in a group setting. Students do not need any instruments to attend choir classes.
