#### Viognier 2009, Paso Robles

Aromas of orange blossom and spice. Medium-bodied and refreshingly dry. Flavors of white peach, apricot, and tropical mango.

#### Tuna Tartare ahi tuna, avocado espuma, lime, citrus mango, baguette crisp

#### Rhone du Robles 2007, Central Coast

Our Rhone style blend is a concentrated, ruby-red wine with aromas of cherry and cranberry and hints of black pepper and spice.

#### Mozzarella Crostinis with diced tomatoes, shallots, and basil pistou

#### Syrah 2008, Paso Robles

A well-structured wine with interesting nuances of blackberry, cocoa and caramel. Deep ruby-red color and opulent fruit flavors of plum and black cherry.
