

***Amazing Harlem Challenge*** - Scavenger Hunt, Trivial Pursuit theme based tours! Do you have what it takes to cross the finish line? What better way to learn about Harlem's rich history by working your way through the neighborhood with clues/riddles for you to solve. New found network of friendships awaits you on the magical journey and adventure, no one is too old or too young to test their wits and guts. Come one come all and experience a different way to learning about the other upper half of an magical island we call Manhattan, ***Welcome to Harlem*** the black Mecca of the world.

**Task** – Each task will be awarded points on the level of difficult and can be prorated. You can earn between 0 – 15 points depending on the task.

**Fast Forward** - Be lucky enough to pick the right item and step the next challenge. You will receive the points allocated to that challenge without having to perform it.

**Rewined** -You will look back at a clue to proceed to the next challenge.

**Pause** - A bonus question you answer for additional points there will be a two minute time limit to answer the question as a group. You will be awarded all of points or nothing.

**Roadblock** - This is a task that one person on the team must perform.

**Life Line** - One call per team for additional clues - 5 will be deducted if used.

The first team to arrive will receive 15 additional points, the second team will receive 10 additional points and the third team will receive 5 additional points.

The team with the most points wins. Remember just because you come in first you may not win the race!!!!

- Be prepared for a day of running and/or walking
